

Guarantee

To be covered by this guarantee:

1. The dog must have been sold as breeding quality.
2. The original purchaser must still own the dog.
3. The dog must not have sired or whelped a litter.
4. The dog must carry the DORNSCHATTEN prefix in his registered name.
5. The dog must be checked for hip dysplasia and eye disorders by age four.

In the event that this dog has hip dysplasia or genetic eye problems, when the above conditions have been met, a replacement puppy of equal quality will be furnished by the breeder from the next available litter or future litters of up to one year. The affected dog must be neutered, spayed, and/or proof of such action and a written diagnosis of the problem by a veterinarian must be submitted to the breeder. Upon receipt of written proof of such defect from the OFA or a certified Canine Eye Ophthalmologist, the breeder will date the order of choosing from the next available litter or from future litters of up to one year.
